Periods being modelled: 1930s

Description of the layout

Ash Valley is a small town cut off the rest of the line. It is a large O gauge layout in an inverted L shape. The layout can be exhibited the factory section as a stand alone unit.

The layout is modelling the early to mid 1930s era for an independent railway which escaped the grouping of 1923 within LMS having the main running rights over the track but a wide variety of other private locos operating as well.

The canal section is shown below.
